The following is our Statement of Faith, which is meant to assure people that we strive to faithfully uphold the essential truths of the Bible.

<u>God</u>

There is ONE true, living God, who is the Creator and Ruler of the universe made up of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each is eternally existent, diverse in operation. The Father initiates the godhead's will and all things will be submitted to Him.
